### ***What is the Coulwood Hills Community Council?***

The Coulwood Hills Community Council was established in 1958 as a “Non-Profit” Corporation for the homeowners in Coulwood Hills development. The governing body is the Board of Directors elected from the Council membership and responsible for the common Coulwood Hills property; Clubhouse, Pool, Playground, etc. Participation and membership is VOLUNTARY. The Council is NOT a Home Owners Association (HOA) with mandatory dues or fees. In the early years Council membership was very active in supporting community groups and interest in building a pool became a reality. As Coulwood Hills grew the increase in membership even supported enlarging the pool to decrease the waiting list to join.

After location, value is the most important consideration in homeownership. To maintain Coulwood Hills home values the stability of owners and the amenities available is critical. Just volunteering to join the Council provides financial stability for maintaining the Clubhouse and playground.
