#### President's Remarks (CF)

 Really excited about new happenings in the neighborhood; pool season is coming up and 4<sup>th</sup> of July

## Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes (CD)

- April 2023 Minutes
  - o JB motion, RB 2<sup>nd</sup>, all in favor- approved

#### Treasurer's Report (JM)

- Approval of April 2023 Budget report
  - April pool sponsorship + 5k sponsor
  - Individual donations
  - Pool memberships continue to come through (approx. \$13k)
  - Clubhouse rentals in red this week due to refunded deposits; this is atypical
  - Advertising + pool management fees
  - \$98,233 total equity for 2023

- o RB motion to approve; JB 2<sup>nd</sup>; all in favor- approved
- CF commented on the huge effort it has been to get us in the green for accounting; audience round of applause
- Fiscal Year 2022-2023 review; budget vs. actuals
  - JM welcomes any questions <u>treasurer.coulwoodhills@gmail.com</u>
  - Large items:
    - individual donations significantly higher than budgeted
    - not all grant money has been redeemed yet
    - pool memberships, council memberships, and clubhouse rentals were over budgeted amount
    - pool management contract with Trident is the largest chunk of our budget
    - far over projections for our revenue from FY 2022/23
  - o motion to approve JB, BM 2<sup>nd</sup>; all in favor; approved
- Budget proposal for 2023-2024 Fiscal Year
  - Projected in the red until March 2024
  - Budget is conservative but projected realistic
    - Individual donations \$11k projected
    - Planning to keep pool memberships
    - Approx. same in clubhouse rentals; slight increase in concessions
    - Utilities and food may go up, so those projections have also increased
    - Largest expenditures:
      - Pool construction loan to go into effect \$25k down payment in Sept '23; \$4k each month after (for 15 years)
        - This would lower if we can do a higher down payment
      - January '24 beginning maintenance and improvement fund \$500/month to be set aside
      - Projections are in the early stages right now (CF)
  - $\circ$  RB motion to approve; CD 2<sup>nd</sup>; all in favor- approved

#### **Committee Reports**

### Welcoming/Public Relations

- (CF) Open position on our board; currently JB and CF handling; use of social media and email blasts
  - Will look into starting texts

#### <u>Clubhouse</u> (RB)

Going well

- Projections this year should increase due to recent price increase; ~70% of rentals are out of neighborhood, which cost more
- May not have gotten Lowe's grant, as we have not heard back

#### Membership/Grievance (JB)

- 35 council members (22 new)
- 122 pool members (36 new)
- We need 17 more family memberships for pool to pay fully for Trident contract in memberships
- Membership forms to be left at pool desk for new registration

#### Entertainment/Athletic (BM+ SM)

- Swim team sign ups have started; email <u>coulwoodbarracudas@gmail.com</u>; pool members get a coupon code for registration
  - will have a swim clinic this year
  - currently 28 kids signed up
  - will represent at vendor fair this Saturday
  - o any volunteers, email BM at email above
- still in need of coaches, if anyone would like to refer including high school and college students
- 2 home meets this year; all proceeds to go to pool renovations!
- 2 companies agreed to sponsor our swim meets: June 20th, July 6th
  - Laura Maultsby Realty (bringing people in to serve food)
  - Smile Pediatric Dentistry; also gold sponsor (\$500)
- Pool sponsorship tiers available this year; available on website now and fliers available
- Suit fittings on May 16

## **Building/Grounds/Maintenance** (MZ)

- Round of applause for GD for his stage building at the park
- Thank you to Hillcrest Baptist for support during clean up and volunteering days
  - Text MZ if interested in volunteering; email us via Coulwood.org
  - If anything in disarray at the park; email us and we will contact MZ
- still some cleaning to be done at the pool house
  - o pool is filled; pumps are running
  - concrete contractor checked in to see if any further repairs need to be done
  - health inspection scheduled for next week
  - MZ will continue to repair as needed
  - WA asked about women's bathroom floor

- Offered with Valerie Comito to buy paint
- CF plans to come up with solutions for these projects that are longer lasting than just a pool season
- CF shouted out Oates Plumbing (lives on Gum Branch) to fix up the showers in the bathrooms at the pool house

#### Pool Renovation Fundraising Committee (JB, JM, BM)

- Fundraising
  - Summer fundraising calendar (JB)
    - plan is to have one event/month, will need volunteers
      - Pizza/sno-cones/popcorn Memorial Day
      - Hoe-Down at the Park Friday June 9th
      - o Ice Cream Social July 15th
      - bake sale every Saturday
        - will require consistent volunteers;2/week
        - \$2/each for 50 items
      - o 2 swim meets; back to school bash in August
        - Sign up genius for events and also paper copy for sign ups at meeting tonight
      - envelope wall fundraiser: large board at the entrance, 1-100 numbered for donations; swim team members to decorate index card thank you's
        - may plan to make video to explain plan
      - Event Saturday 10a-3p Arts + Crafts Vendor Fair
        - Coffee to be sold
        - Bob Comito and MAC to grill hot dogs for sale
        - 12 vendors currently; 5 @ \$25, 7 @ \$20; x2 tent rentals for \$10/ea
        - Not charging children for vending
        - Hope to raise money for pool
- Budgeting + Accounting (CF)
  - Still in preliminary phases; contacting banks
- Project Mgmt + Operations (CF+MZ)
  - Proposal back from pool designer

- Discussion with designer and contractor to trim back areas, as overall cost is higher than anticipated
  - Most important are pool + infrastructure
  - Will include bathhouses due to ADA requirements
  - Unclear about parking lot as of now
- No reason why we can't meet deadline of opening for '24 season
- In next few weeks, planning to have a 4x8 sign outside the pool with renderings of planned proposal
- Realistically hopeful for more of a \$500k range, which is what proposed in the budget for this coming year

### **New Business/Community updates**

- Pool party rentals to be available to pool members (JM)
  - Flier upcoming to be posted in pool house
  - Will be on a case-by-case basis to be approved by board
  - Forego guest fees by having set up ahead of time; will include a concession, etc.
    - Board wants to be prepared for numbers, too with lifeguards
- Pool open and free to all on Memorial Day Monday
- Proposal for new door lock on pool (JM)
  - JM's husband is researching right now
  - Propose to approve a maximum for a door lock of \$400
    - Options include: code, RFID tags
    - Each family would have 2 RFID tags
    - Setting to hold open for swim meets
    - Would come with 3 physical keys
    - Would need a replacement fee for key fobs ~\$15-20

- May take over the sign in sheet
  - will need to stay just for guest sign in
- will be nice to have data for hours
- RB motion to approve; BM 2<sup>nd</sup>; all in favor- approved
